



Junior Golf League

We will start the season with a Kick Off Registration, Informational (mandatory), and Buffet (optional) Event. During the League, each week the juniors will be involved in a ½ hour group lesson. After the lesson some of the juniors will be placed in groups to play their respective number of holes. The lessons will change each week and cover all aspects of the game. The lessons include: rules and etiquette, driver and woods, irons, chipping, pitching and putting. For those going on the course, play will begin with a shotgun start and a volunteer will be assigned to each group. The final week will include the Putting Championship, Junior Club Championships, Pizza Party and Awards.

Our goal at SCCC is to be the best Junior Golf Program in Central Minnesota. We need your help in a couple of ways: sign your children up for the program, attend the Kick Off Event, and volunteer a few mornings to walk with a group. It is very important that we get help from parents and guardians each week chaperoning the 4 & 9-hole groups. These are the only two leagues that need volunteers to chaperone. These leagues will take approximately 2½ hours of your morning. We ask for your help in improving your Junior Golf Program.

HOW TO PLACE YOUR JUNIORS IN THE PROPER GROUP (MINIMUM AGE OF 6):

Below you will see brief descriptions of the 4 different groups. Please sign you juniors up in the group that matches their abilities closest. If you have questions or concerns' call that golf shop and ask for Chad or Matt. The golf shop will move juniors from group to group throughout the season. Juniors will be expected to carry their own golf clubs.

- Rangers Group Juniors new to the game of golf. This introductory group will spend thirty minutes with the golf staff learning the fundamentals of the golf, etiquette and rules. (Ages range 6-11)
- 4-Hole Group Juniors with some knowledge of the golf course. Participants in this group must be able to advance the ball on every shot. They will play a short course with holes ranging from 75 to 200 yards and will play until 10:00. (Age range 8-13)
- 9-Hole Group Juniors with a strong grasp of the game of golf, but don't want to quite make the leap to 18 holes. They need a little endurance and a little more experience. All play will be from the gold tees for boys and red tees for girls and must be able to play the course in two hours. (Age range 11-17)

Advance 9-Hole Group Juniors wanting to play competitive golf that can play 9-holes in 2-hours. They will also get a chance to play with other area High School Juniors. All play will be from the white tees for boys and red tees for girls. Weekly games will make golf fun and exciting, along with some great competition. (Age range 14-18)
